JUNIOR MINISTRY CONGREGATION PASTOR (YOUTH)

Description: The successful candidate for this role will provide pastoral leadership and oversight to the youth (age 12-18) of the Junior Ministry Congregation (JMC). There are currently around 50 members in the JMC youth ministry. He or she will champion overall church direction in the JMC youth ministry and reports to the Senior Pastor.

Description of our Church: ECAC is a multi-language church in Edmonton with a heart to discern where God is leading us and follow Him faithfully. Our vision statement is “To make fully devoted followers of Jesus”.

Who We’re Looking For: Someone who is Christ-Centered, Spirit-Empowered, and Mission-Focused in their life and ministry. He or she will depend on God through prayer and will exemplify spiritual maturity and continuous growth through their own life and conduct. He or she will have a passion to teach and help our community to grow in Christ. We are willing to work with this person’s giftings to ensure they are thriving through their ministry passions in this role.

Qualifications:

- A bachelor’s or master’s degree in pastoral ministry
- A Canadian citizen or Permanent Residence of Canada
- Accredited or willing to be accredited with the Alliance Canada
- Strong public and interpersonal communication skills
- Experience leading Christian youth ministries
- Ability to work well in a team
- Successful completion of a criminal background check including vulnerable sectors check

Responsibilities:

1. Leadership and Oversight
 - Chair of the JMC youth council *ex officio*
 - Ensure the direction of the youth ministry aligns with the overall direction of ECAC
 - Equip and train youth leaders to disciple youth members
 - Supervise summer students hired through Canada Summer Jobs program
 - Organize youth retreats (winter / spring), David Camp (summer)
 - Organize youth mission trips (local and global)
2. Preaching & Teaching Ministries
 - Preach and teach regularly at JMC youth services¹, Sunday School, fellowships

¹ Currently, youth services take place two Sundays in a month. During other Sundays, the youths are asked to attend the English-speaking service.





- Occasionally preach at other language congregational services
- 3. Pastoral Care
 - Provide pastoral care to all JMC leaders
 - Visit youths and their families
 - Attend and/or lead weekly JMC prayer meetings
- 4. Personal/Professional Development & District Responsibilities
 - Ongoing development as a pastor: ordination work (if applicable), studies, youth pastor conferences
 - Network with other Alliance pastors and leaders and maintain a good relationship with the district
 - Attend Alliance district and national events
- 5. Churchwide / Pastoral Team Engagement
 - Attend and engage in weekly pastoral staff meetings
 - Help with church-wide events (e.g., outreach events, joint prayer meetings)
 - Foster pastoral team relationships and strive for good connections and teamwork
 - Participate in church-wide leadership discernment
 - Assist JMC children's ministry if available

Position Type: Full-time, salary range of \$50,000-60,000 per year, based on experience and qualifications.
